Infection control has always been a top priority for our practice and you may have seen this during your visits to our office. Our office is following infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association (ADA), the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). We follow the activities of these agencies so that we are up-to-date on any new rulings or guidance that may be issued.

You may see some changes when it is time for your next appointment. We made these changes to help protect our patients and staff. For example:

- We have hand sanitizer that we will ask you to use when you enter the office.
- Once you have sanitized your hands, our office will ask that you complete a screening form.
- Prior to being taken to the back office, your temperature will be taken.
- You may see that our waiting room will no longer offer magazines, children's toys and so forth, since those items are difficult to clean and disinfect.
- Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients. That might mean that you're offered fewer options for scheduling your appointment.
- We will do our best to allow greater time between patients to reduce waiting times for you, as well as to reduce the number of patients in the reception area at any one time. We ask that you please do not bring siblings, friends or relatives who do not have a scheduled appointment.

Our office is proceeding with an abundance of caution but want you to feel as confident as we do that any visit you make to our office will be a safe one. We are happy to answer any questions you may have about the steps we take to keep you, and every patient, safe in our practice.
